Staff Sergeant Tate:

The Regina Qu'Appelle Health Regina in collaboration with Saskatchewan Polytechnical offers the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner course to experienced registered nurses, particularly Regina examiners. An excellent video clip of Corporal Shannon Gordon is imbedded in the web portion of the course which effectively speaks to the laws and the general role of peace officers as investigators. Although Shannon's portion has been valuable for our education, I have realized over time that our nurses have little understanding of the fine points of investigation and the ethical decisions with which officers are confronted in working with victims.

Linvited Constable Grant Campbell to speak to this class on December 11<sup>th</sup> about some of the aspects of investigation and the ethical concerns which are largely invisible to nurses who care for victims of sexual violence. My hope was that the nurses would have a greater appreciation for the thought that goes into a police investigation.

I was not disappointed. Grant spoke in an engaging manner that held our attention. More important than his style, his content allowed us to have a greater sense of the compassion and thoughtfulness that officers bring to interactions with victims. He also left us with an understanding of the difficulty and with what expertise officers must pursue their investigations of reported sexual assault.

Thank you for permitting Grant to speak to our nurses. The Regina Qu'Appelle Health Region Forensic Nursing Program is very grateful for our collegial relationship with Regina Police Service.

On August 5th, 2015 my ex husband (Dave) and three kids (Connor, 6, Owen, 3 and Avrie 7months) were in a vehicle collision on the ring road. I believe they called me before 911 as I got there before the first responders and got to witness how each of them dealt with the situation. First on the scene were Officers Tim Logan and Keith Salamon. Upon learning that my 6 year old, Connor had sustained an injury (very small, just a black eye), they made him their first and top priority. I am sorry, I only learned their names the next day and am not sure which officer was which, but the first one hung out with Connor until EMS and the Fire Department showed up. He only had a black eye, but was pretty shaken up. The officer told Connor how tough he looked, how brave he was, showed Con his own scar and was overall just really empathetic and caring towards him.

Once EMS and The Fire department were on the scene, the officers went on to handle their business and I have to say both EMS and the Firemen were outstanding as well. Everyone went above and beyond to make sure that my children were not only physically okay but emotionally as well. Every single person on site played a part to make sure my children felt safe and important, like their wellbeing mattered more than anything. What no one realized was this was one of their first visits with their dad since our separation and they were on their way to Chuck-E-Cheese, as suggested by Connor - who felt that the accident was his fault (if he hadn't picked that destination, they wouldn't have been on that road). He is so sensitive and dealing with so much right now, that extra kindness went a long way. (I wish I knew all of the first responders names and if you have access to that information, I would love if you could forward this to the appropriate people ① !)

At one point, one of the firemen saw Owen looking left out in the back seat from his big brother stealing the show and climbed right into my minivan and carried on a conversation with him. To pick up on that and then to make the effort to make it right, was touching. For over an hour, my children got to look at different uniforms, tell their stories, laugh and hang out with real life super heroes! As a mom, this was amazing to watch. I have tried to talk to my kids about police and firefighters being our friends and tell them that that we can ask them for help if we are scared, lost or hurt but adults are scary to kids. Serious looking adults in a uniform, even more so. Their first encounter couldn't have gone any better. I feel more confidant now, that my children would seek out the appropriate "friend" should they ever need to. Before leaving, the second officer got some tattoos for the boys, which made their night! For a solid week, they showed those things off to everyone!

I know these men and women see horrific things and were probably very relieved to tend to an accident on the ring road with the worst injury being a black eye. I can't imagine how difficult this job has to be. I feel like first responders are under appreciated - but especially the police -and even more so these days with all the negative attention they get in the media. To have a job where you deal daily with the things no one else can handle or even imagine and to still be so warm and caring takes such a special soul! I can't say thank you enough! Real. Life. Superheroes! Thank you, thank you, THANK YOU for all you do and deal with and for still being so amazing! I know it's not much, but next time they are having a rough night, I would like them to have a coffee on me and know that their job is so important and they are appreciated!

#### Alex's Background

- not attending school, nor was he engaging in school when he did attend.
- diagnosed with ADHD, arxiety & depression.
- very withdrawn & anti-social & kept teachers & classmates at bay.
- mumbled when he spoke, looked at no one & mom was actively engaged with TRIP,

- mom spent almost every morning of the remaining school year driving him to school.
- last year school goal was to just get him inside the building.
- April 2014, TRiP began working with Alex.
- as a result of Alex's mom driving him to school daily, he only missed 43 school days last year, though many times he would refuse to get out of the van.
- this year, the school, TRiP staff & morn recognized that Alex was ready to do more than simply show up. Alex started out in September attending 1/2 days, but at times was still refusing to get out of the van.

- at a September TRiP case conference, morn advised TRiP staff that Alex talked constantly about wanting a chameleon. (She noted that he never asks for anything but this keeps coming up).
- it was suggested that TRiP implement a goal reward chart for Alex to earn a chameleon to keep in the classroom & that he would have responsibility for.

- in October, Alex started working towards achieving his final goal (getting a chameleon), while accomplishing smaller milestones along the way.
- he was required to be in the classroom for the morning & to make an effort. The "effort" was to be determined by Alex's
- when Cst. Seiferling SEO, first met Alex, he avoided eye contact & mumbled one or two word answers.
- at the point of receiving his 1st milestone reward, Alex had started spending more than the required time in class.
- by month-end, reached his 2<sup>nd</sup> milestone marker & was rewarded with a trip to a pet store where he got to hold a chameleon & pick out a terrarium & supplies.
- during this pet store visit, Alex was engaging in conversation, making eye contact & spoke with the staff.
- he has participated in a school dance contest & was spending almost full days in the classroom, & producing quality work.
- currently, he is in class for most of the day & despite the odd slow start, he participates in class & interacts with a variety of
- if he continues on his projected course, Alex will be getting the chameleon in school in the New Year.
