CONCLUSION

The crime statistics for the month of September 2016 reflect a decrease in Crimes Against the Person of [-1.0%] compared to September 2015, while Crimes Against Property show a 15.0% increase compared to September 2015. Crimes Against the Person and Crimes Against Property show a combined year-to-date increase of 11.9%.

BACKGROUND

Each month, reports providing statistics for the City of Regina are presented to the Board for their review and information. This report will provide statistics for the month of September 2016. The Communications Centre statistics are included showing the total calls for service.

DISCUSSION

Crimes Against Property reflect an increase of 1,199 reported incidents over 2015, for an overall year-to-date increase of 15.0%. We have seen an increase of 541 reported incidents of Theft Under \$5000 for a 15.6% increase. There are 154 more reported incidents of Mischief / Wilful Damage for an 8.5% increase.

Thefts of Auto rates have increased by 128 incidents for an overall increase of 18.3% in our year-to-date statistics. The Regina Police Service in conjunction with its partners in the Stolen Auto Strategy continues to pay constant attention to this issue.

Crimes Against the Person reflect a year-to-date decrease of [-20] incidents over September 2015 for a [-1.0%] decrease. There were 29 reported Robberies in September for a year-to-date increase of 17 incidents or an increase of 9.3%.

Overall the Regina Police Service has received 1,179 more reported incidents of Crimes Against the Person and Crimes Against Property combined in 2016 over 2015 for an 11.9% increase.

There were a total of 7,752 dispatched Calls for Service in September for a year-to-date increase of 2.0% and Alarm Calls for Service show a year-to-date decrease of [-16.7%].

CONCLUSION

The crime statistics for the month of October 2016 reflect a decrease in Crimes Against the Person of [-0.2%] compared to October 2015, while Crimes Against Property show a 13.5% increase compared to October 2015. Crimes Against the Person and Crimes Against Property show a combined year-to-date increase of 9.4%.

BACKGROUND

Each month, reports providing statistics for the City of Regina are presented to the Board for their review and information. This report will provide statistics for the month of October 2016. The Communications Centre statistics are included showing the total calls for service.

DISCUSSION

Crimes Against Property reflect an increase of 1,247 reported incidents over 2015, for an overall year-to-date increase of 13.5%. We have seen an increase of 609 reported incidents of Theft Under \$5000 for a 15.4% increase. There are 57 more reported incidents of Mischief / Wilful Damage for a 2.6% increase.

Thefts of Auto rates have increased by 134 incidents for an overall increase of 16.4% in our year-to-date statistics. The Regina Police Service in conjunction with its partners in the Stolen Auto Strategy continues to pay constant attention to this issue.

Crimes Against the Person reflect a year-to-date decrease of [-4] incidents over October 2015 for a [-0.2%] decrease. There were 27 reported Robberies in October for a year-to-date increase of 26 incidents or an increase of 13.1%.

Overall the Regina Police Service has received 992 more reported incidents of Crimes Against the Person and Crimes Against Property combined in 2016 over 2015 for a 9.4% increase.

There were a total of 7,701 dispatched Calls for Service in October for a year-to-date increase of 1.9% and Alarm Calls for Service show a year-to-date decrease of [-16.9%].
