

## Protect Your Residence

- Lock doors of home and sheds
- Close garage doors
- Secure windows
- Install an alarm system
- When out of town, have your yard and home monitored
- Collect mail regularly
- Utilize timers on lights
- Record serial numbers and take pictures of valuable property

## Crime Prevention Through Environment Design (CPTED)

- Trim shrubs and trees
- Ensure appropriate lighting
- Install quality locks, motion lights, and video surveillance
- Keep windows and walkways free of visual obstruction
- Maintain a tidy and well kept yard

## Bike Theft

- Use a highly durable lock like a U-lock vs chain
- Consider key lock seats and wheels versus quick release
- Remove seat
- Make your bike unique or distinguishable
- Store bike inside a secure location at night
- Take note of the serial number and store in a safe place

## Scams

Utilize anti-theft devices

Remove valuable items from the visible interior
