Bike Theft

Use a highly <mark>durable lock</mark> like a U-lock vs chain

Consider key lock seats and wheels versus quick release Remove seat Make your bike unique or distinguishable

Store bike inside a secure location at night

Take note of the serial number and store in a safe place

Trim shrubs and trees

Ensure appropriate lighting

Install quality locks, motion lights, and video surveillance

Keep windows and walkways free of visual obstruction
